FINAL CONCLUSIONS

from the general discussions of the participants of the Conference:

1. To create a Working Group named "Physical properties and processes of agricultural materials".

2. To organize the Secretariat of the Working Group at the Institute of Agrophysics of the Polish Academy of Sciences, located in Lublin, Poland.

3. To organize every 4 year international congresses on the physical properties of plant materials in different countries.

4. To consider the possibility of organizing the next conference in Hungary.

5. To appoint Prof. Dr I. Huszar the Chairmen of the Working Group (the Chairman of the Working Group will be nominated from the country responsible for the organization of the Congress).

6. To publish in Poland every 4 year a multilingual catalogue comprising the limit values of physical properties of plant materials, the unification of investigation methods and information abount new measurement apparati.

7. Every 2 year to print in foreign languages original papers connected with the discussed problems as an edition of the Polish Academy of Sciences.

8. To oblige the Secretariat to work out normatives and definitions connected with the physical properties of plant materials in comparison with standards used in other countries.

9. To cause the choice of representatives of different countries for the coordination of investigations in their countries and the maintenance of contacts with the Secretariat of the Working Group.

The Mangament Committee of the International Commission of Agricultural Engineering (CIGR) at a sitting in Paris on 9th March, 1977, passed the motion of creating a Scientific Working Group (within Section III) under the name proposed, and of establishing the Secretariat of the Group.
